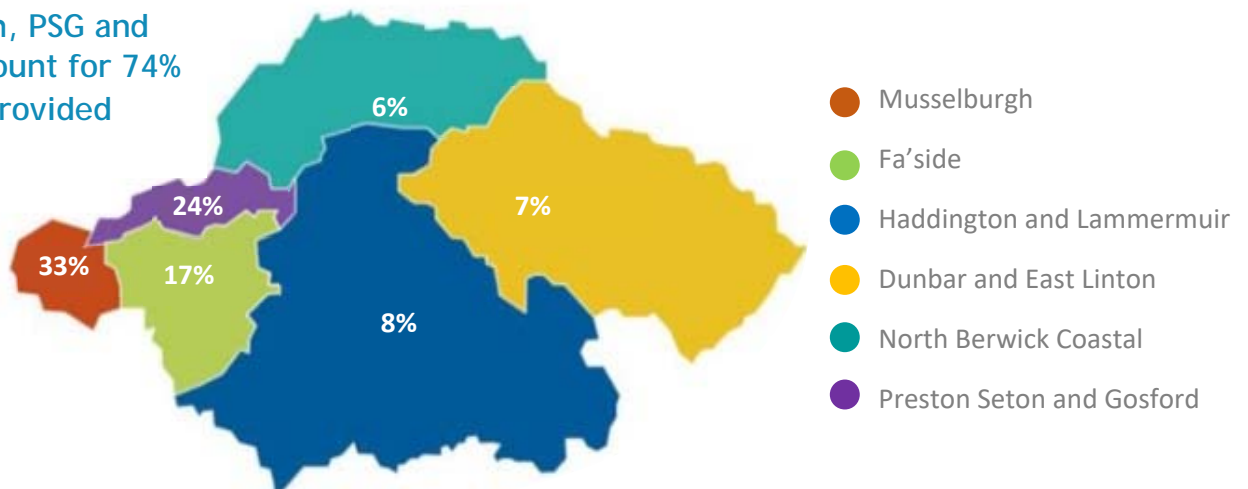
### Top 3 reasons for referrals

- 1** 34% due to benefit changes or delays
- 2** 30% due to a refused crisis grant
- 3** 24% due to low income

During May 2018, ¼ of all referrals were received from the Scottish Welfare Fund. Other major sources of referrals included Musselburgh CAB, East Lothian Council criminal justice and social work teams

## How many people did we feed? Who received our parcels? Top 3 reasons for referrals

 **4326 people fed**  
(This includes multiple referrals)

 **Of these 36% (1568) were under the age of 16**

-  50% to single people
-  23% to single parents with child
-  13% to families
-  10% to couples
-  4% to other

- 1** 36% due to benefit changes or delays
- 2** 28% due to low income
- 3** 26% due refused crisis grant

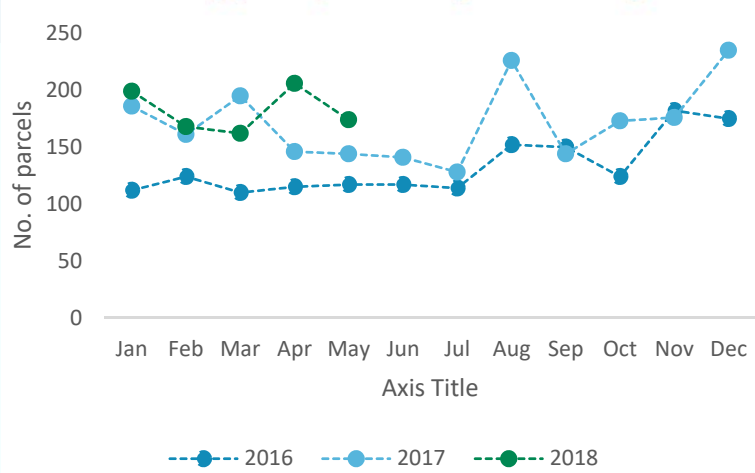

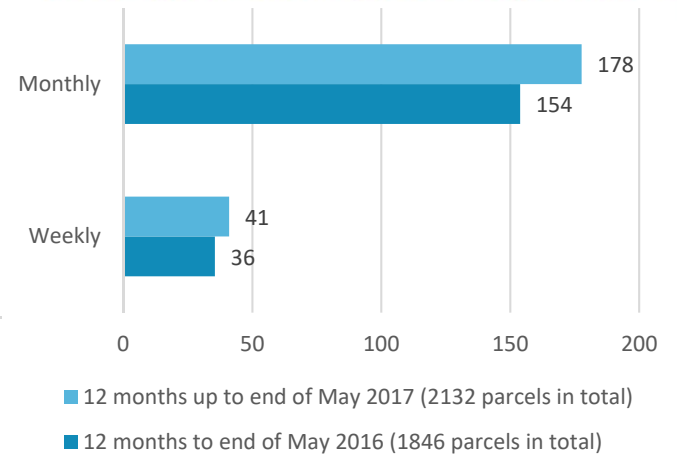
