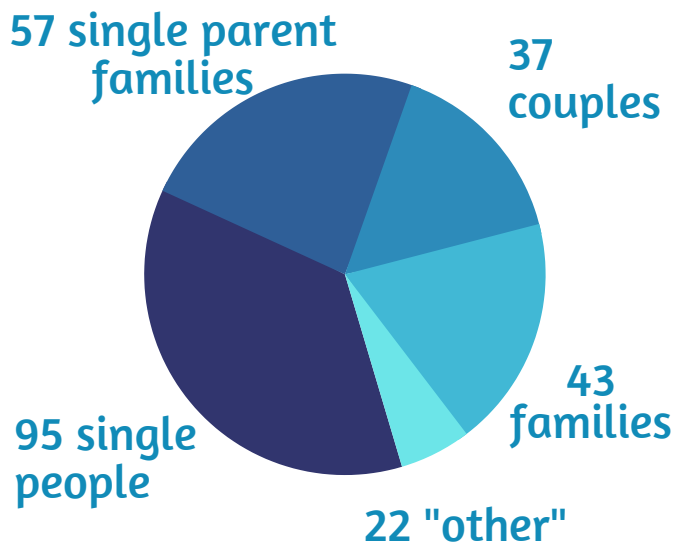
 254, 3-day emergency food parcels given out



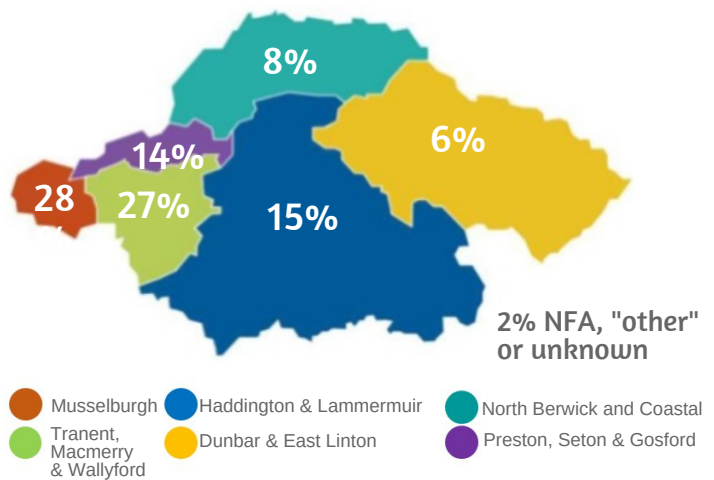
606 people fed

Reasons for referrals



*Delayed wages, sickness, homeless, domestic violence, refused STBA, child holiday meals, other

47% of referrals in July were due to "low income", with benefit delays/changes (15%), refused crisis grant (13%) and debt (8%) accounting for just over 1/3 of referrals

Who sends us referrals?

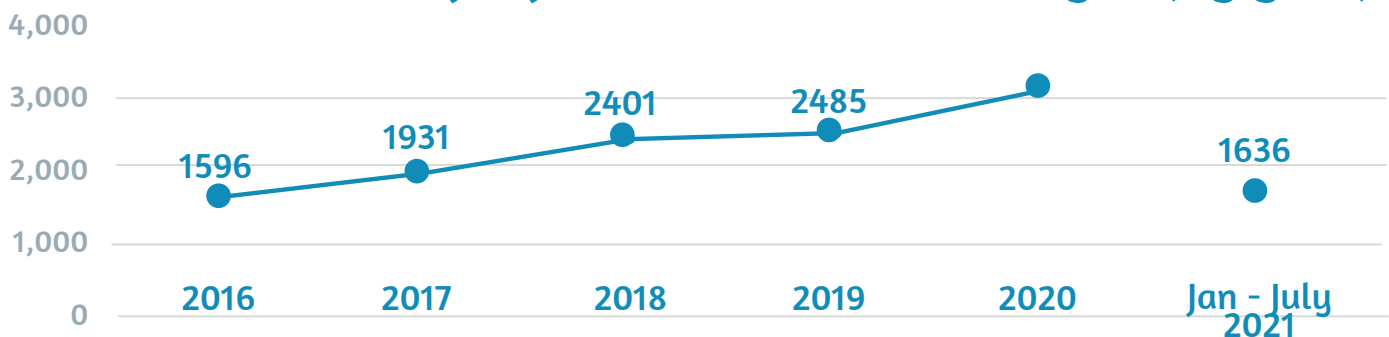
Everyone who receives a food parcel is referred to us by one of our partner organisations across the county

In July the largest number of referrals from a single agency came from the Scottish Welfare Fund (15%) and Musselburgh Citizen Advice Bureau (15%). Referrals from East Lothian Council departments accounted for 31% and NHS services accounted for 21% of all referrals received .
