1343 people fed 507 children








Support requests from our local CAB offices, NHS services and East Lothian Council services account for over 2/3 of all referrals received and Musselburgh CAB continues to be our busiest individual referrer, accounting for over 20% of all referrals.

During December we saw an increase in the number of people coming to us directly to ask for support. In these cases we worked with the household to provide emergency food and details of support services.

WHY WAS HELP NEEDED?

Low income was given as the reason for support being needed in over 81% of referrals


